The applicant shall prepare a statement of 300 words or less setting forth his or her vocational or professional goal and relate how past, present and future activities will make the accomplishment of this goal probable. The applicant by deed and circumstance must demonstrate his or her worthiness. The letter must be signed.
6. Application must be signed by the applicant and by the principal or a present teacher.
